## Southern Arizona Watercolor Guild SIGNATURE Status Documentation

If you wish to apply for SAWG <u>Signature</u> Status, you must keep track of the acceptances of your paintings in five designated juried shows AFTER you have received Juried Status. Eligible shows are designated by SAWG Board of Directors. These Shows are established to be of high quality and generally are juried by an artist with a national reputation. A painting may not be used more than once to obtain a point. After you have received Signature Status you may use the SAWG initials after your painting signature. At present the following shows are designated point shows for SAWG Signature Status.

SAWG Color My World Show SAWG Lasting Impressions Show SAWG Fiesta Sonora Show SAWG Annual Show Western Federation of Watercolor Societies Annual Show Arizona Aqueous Annual Show in Tubac Arizona Watercolor Association Spring Show Arizona Watercolor Association Fall Show

Accepted documentation may be for only one type of show, for example any five separate SAWG shows, OR a combination of shows listed above which add up to five. It is the number of shows, not the number of paintings, which are necessary for SAWG Signature Status. For example, two paintings in one show count for one point.
